



(COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES)

*ADVANCE POLL NOVEMBER 19, 2020

*ELECTION DAY NOVEMBER 26, 2020

PROCEDURES:

- Election staff will be equipped with PPE
- When doors open, ALL PEOPLE ENTERING THE BUILDING WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE CHECKED AND CONTACT INFORMATION TAKEN.
- After temperatures checked, a mask and a pair of gloves will be given to all people entering the building.
- All people entering the building need to be aware that wearing their mask is strictly enforced.
- Hand sanitizers will be located at key areas in the building
- As Elders and handicapped persons (or a parent with children) arrive, a Monitor will usher them to the front of the line

- If the weather is adverse, Monitors will issue a numbered ticket to have voter wait in vehicle until number is called; once number called, voter can wait next in line at entrance of building
- Maximum number of people allowed in the building will be as per Director of Emergency Management's (DEM) instructions on day of Advance Poll and day of Election.
- Everyone is to follow the **6 ft distance requirement** as a safety measure
- Washrooms will not be available to the public
