

# COVID-19 TESTING



- Effective December 23, 2021, people who have received a positive result from a rapid test are only recommended to book a confirmatory PCR COVID-19 test with BTDH if they meet the eligibility criteria for Sotrovimab treatment.
- For all others who have received a positive result from a rapid test, a confirmatory test is no longer required. If you test positive on a rapid test, you must isolate immediately.
  - If you are symptomatic, a single rapid test is considered a true positive and you must isolate for at least 10 days from when your symptoms started. Call 403-737-8411 to see if you qualify for the drug treatment.
  - If you are asymptomatic, isolate for 24 hours and then repeat the rapid test. If the second test is positive as well, you must isolate for 10 days from the first positive test. If the second test is negative, you can consider the first test to be a false positive and no further measures are required as long as you still have no symptoms.
- Testing from BTDH continues to be available for:
  - People with symptoms of COVID-19 who do not have a positive rapid test result;
  - People connected to an outbreak;
  - People who have been told by Public Health to get a test.
