General Description: Assistant Field Technician will assist in several sectors of Blood Tribe Land Management department. The specific areas will be with Agricultural, Environmental Protection and Geomatics Service Delivery Areas.

Major Duties and Responsibilities: The incumbent will be assisting with *Agricultural Services* with appropriate range, water and fencing assessments of all pastures on Blood Reserve, documenting and reporting grazing activities; Also will assist with monitoring of permit lands (cropping); Assist with *Livestock Control* staff when necessary; Assist with *Geomatics Services* staff in utilizing Global Positioning Systems (GPS), field investigations and assisting with surveying; assist with *Environmental Protection Services* staff in Plant/Animal Data Collection and Assessments; Incumbent will also be responsible for entering relevant data into Blood Tribe Land Management database.

- Knowledge of sustainable livestock grazing and range management;
- Knowledgeable with Microsoft programs;
