- Monitor number of participants attending all groups and provides reports
- Facilitate prevention groups including cultural groups, talking circles and prevention education classes
- Other duties as assigned by the Opioid Response Culture Coordinator

**NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:**

- Must Demonstrate sensitivity, empathy regarding human services issues. Also, must project a non-judgmental attitude toward those requiring services.
- Must have facilitation skills and be able to facilitate to members, students, families, employees, elders etc.
- Must be organized and have good time management skills.
- Must be able to deal diplomatically and professionally with staff and public.
- Must be proficient in Microsoft Word Programs (Word, Outlook, Excel, Power Point)
- Must be sensitive to First Nations Cultural Dynamics
- Must practice sobriety and refrain from drugs, alcohol, and opioids.
- Must possess a good understanding of Native culture and issues.

**NECESSARY TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:**

- Must be a post secondary student in Addictions, Counselling and / or Human Services, must have related experience.
- Knowledgeable of Blackfoot culture, protocol, and language.
- Knowledgeable of First Nation community issues and trends.
- Must have a valid Class 5 driver's license and a reliable mode of transportation.
- Must submit an updated Criminal Record Check.
- The Blood Tribe's COVID 19 Vaccination Policy requires all employees to be fully vaccinated. The successful candidate must be fully vaccinated and must provide Blood Tribe Human Resources with proof of vaccination.
